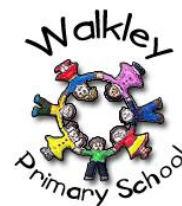

Sheffield Children's Book Awards – Crucible Theatre Friday 10th November 2017

Dear Parents/Carers,

Sheffield Children's Book Awards were launched in 1988 to encourage children and young people to read, and to highlight the best literature published each year. The awards celebrate books and what they do for the Sheffield Community. Hundreds of children from across the city take part every year by voting for their favourite book through local schools and libraries.

During the Summer term your child took part in the city-wide competition, reading a number of books that were shortlisted for the Sheffield Children's Book Awards. They graded the books with a score out of ten which were then submitted to the board for the city-wide vote.

We have been invited to the award ceremony at the Crucible Theatre in Tudor Square, Sheffield at 10am on Friday 10th November, where the 12 pupils who were involved will hear from the winning authors; speaking and reading from their books. In the afternoon, our pupils will be taking part in a meet the author session with **Christopher Edge** the author of **The Many Worlds of Albie Bright**.

We will be travelling to the museum via **tram**. We will be walking between the tram stop and the theatre so it is important that the pupils have suitable shoes that are comfortable to walk in and a warm coat. **The afternoon session will not finish until 2.45pm, so children will not be back at school and ready for collection until approximately 3.30pm.**

There will be no cost for the event but **we do require your permission for your child to participate on the trip.**

Pupils will need a back-pack to carry their lunch and a plastic water bottle. A packed lunch can be provided by school. If you wish school to provide a packed lunch please indicate this below. If your child has specific dietary requirements, please provide them with their own packed lunch.
