

How to uncover a Stegosaurus

Are you mesmerised by the 'thought to be extinct' stegosaurus? Would you love to photograph this incredible creature up close? If so, read on to find out how!

What you need:

- A trail of peanuts (or other tasty plants)
- A pit with steep sides
- A large and attractive edible flower
- A good camera
- A boulder (escape plan)

What you do:

1. First, dig a pit large enough for a stegosaurus. Make sure that your pit has steep sides so that the stegosaurus can't climb out.
2. Next, find a large and attractive edible flower to entice the stegosaurus. Carefully place it in the pit, slightly out of reach.
3. After that, trek through the jungle to where the trees are sparse. You are sure to find a stegosaurus nest here. Always make sure you wear sturdy boots to do this.
4. Then, sprinkle a trail of peanuts from the nest of the stegosaurus to your trap.
5. Once your trail has been laid, find a safe place to hide close to the trap.
6. As soon as you are hidden, wait patiently for the stegosaurus to approach. Even though you will feel excited, make sure that you stay silent. The Stegosaurus will be tempted by the peanuts, but any loud noises or sudden movements could scare it away!
7. Once the stegosaurus has taken the bait and fallen into the trap move quickly so that it doesn't become enraged and accidentally injure itself
8. Finally, peek into the trap and take your chance to photograph the majestic dinosaur.
9. Now you have your precious photograph! Remember to plan an escape route for your creature so that it can free itself from your sturdy trap.
