● To begin to understand Longitude and Latitude (identify what the lines are on a world map) and understand time zones using longitude lines ● Using a range of maps and atlases (digital online mapping and data retrieval (google earth): locate the equator, the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn and the Northern and Southern Hemispheres. ● Label on a world map the countries where Spanish is the primary language used. ● To know that Migration is the movement of people from one place to another. ● Explain the similarities and differences of Sheffield (UK) through the human (population, types of settlement e.g., favelas) and physical features (include climate) ● To use and know the 8 points of a compass ● To use and read 4 figure grid references on maps
