Science

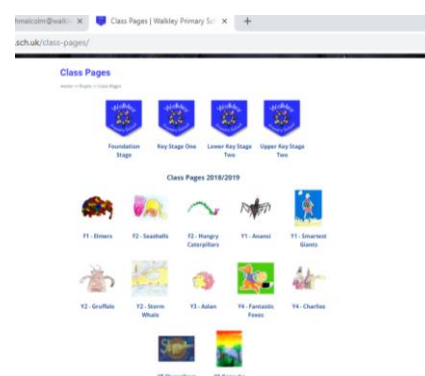
Science and our topic will be:
