Science and our topic will be:

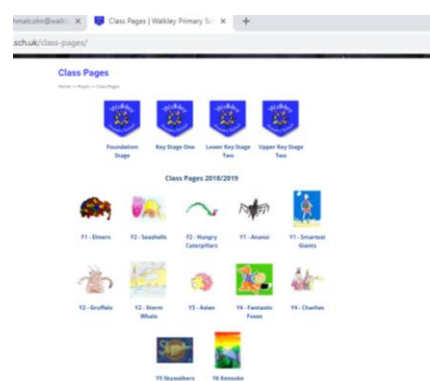
Living things and habitats
