If you had 20 plums and you use 13 to make jam, how many would you have left?



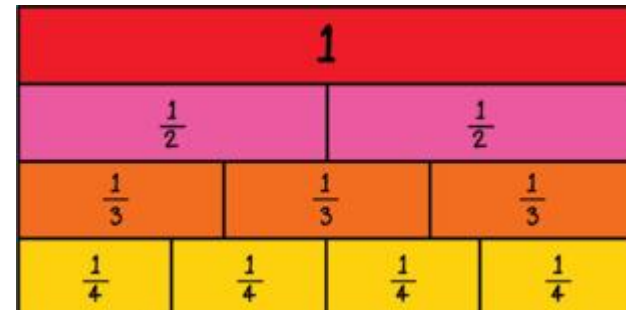
If you had 20 milk cartons and drink 2 of them, how many would you have left?
