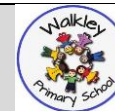


YEAR 6 READING CRUCIAL LEARNING



Year 6	Comprehension	Vocabulary & Meaning	1. Discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.
Year 6		Understanding Key Aspects of Text Type	1. Retrieve, record and present information from non-fiction.
Year 6		Inferring and Deducing	1. Understand what they read by drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence.
Year 6		Checking for Sense	1. Understand what they read by checking that the book makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and exploring the meaning of words in context.
Year 6		Predicting	1. Understand what they read by predicting what might happen from details stated and implied.
Year 6		Listening to & Discussing Text	1. Explain and discuss their understanding of what they have read, including through formal presentations and debates, maintaining a focus on the topic and using notes where necessary. 2. Provide reasoned justifications for their views.
Year 6		Understanding Text and Sequence	1. Understand what they read by summarising the main ideas drawn from more than one paragraph, identifying key details that support the main ideas. 2. Maintain positive attitudes to reading and understanding what they read by identifying and discussing themes and conventions in and across a wide range of writing.
