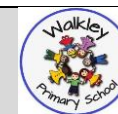


YEAR 1 READING CRUCIAL LEARNING



Year 1	Decoding	Read Write Inc	1. All set 1 sounds 2. Blending set 1 and set 2 sounds 3. Blending set 3 sounds GPC including multisyllabic words (e.g. sunshine)
Year 1		Common Exception Words	1. Read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spelling and sound (Red Words) and where these occur in the word. 2. read words with contractions (for example I'm, I'll, we'll) and understand the apostrophe represents the omitted letter(s)
Year 1		Reading Aloud	1. Read aloud accurately books that are consistent with their developing phonic knowledge and that do not require them to use other strategies to work out words.
Year 1	Comprehension	Vocabulary & Meaning	1. Develop pleasure in reading, motivation to read, vocabulary and understanding by discussing word meanings, linking new meanings to those already known.
Year 1		Inferring and Deducing	1. Understand both the books they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to by making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.
Year 1		Checking for Sense	1. Understand both the books they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to by checking that the text makes sense to them as they read correcting inaccurate reading.
Year 1		Predicting	1. Understand both the books they can already read accurately and fluently and those they listen to by predicting what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far
Year 1		Listening to & Discussing Text	1. Explain clearly their understanding of what is read to them.
