Draw: Your own island map! What natural and man-made geographical landmarks would it have? Which ocean would it be in?	Sing: The plastic bag song by Nick Cope https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=UZQ0L3bolFw	Write and draw: A list of things you will need to travel around the world investigating different oceans and islands. E.g. First Aid kit, scuba gear etc
Research: The incredible Greta Thunberg. (You could start by looking on our blog!)	Design and Make: A submarine to see the incredible creatures found in the depths of the oceans!	Help recycle plastics at home: Help your adults put out the blue bins or take plastics to recycling skips.
