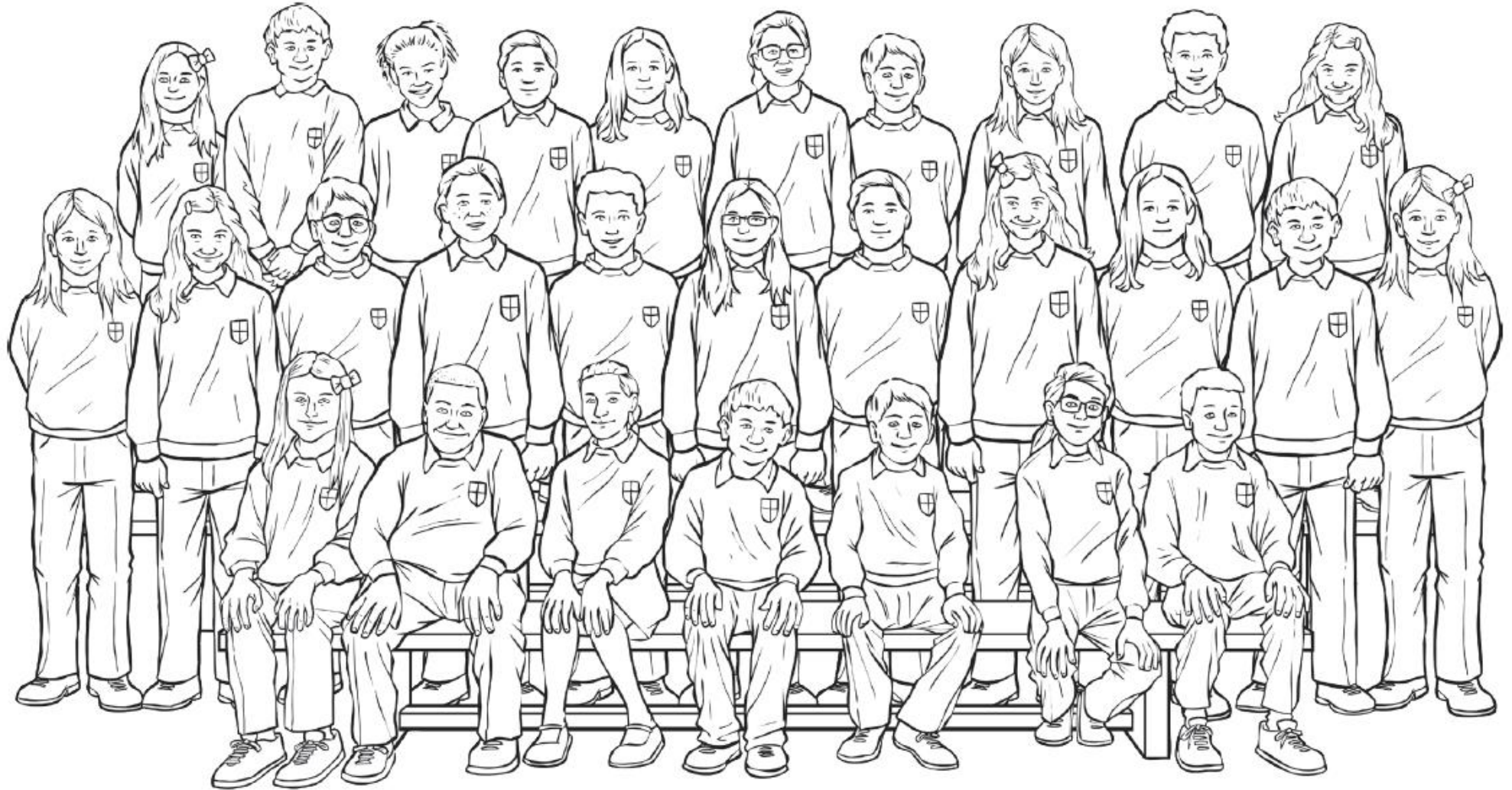


Class Photo
