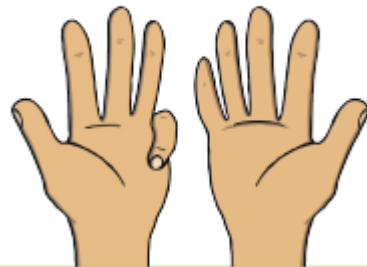

The Hand Trick

You now have 9 digits up - 4 digits to the left (4 tens, one less than the number of nines) and 5 digits to the right (number of ones to make 9).

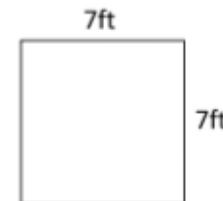

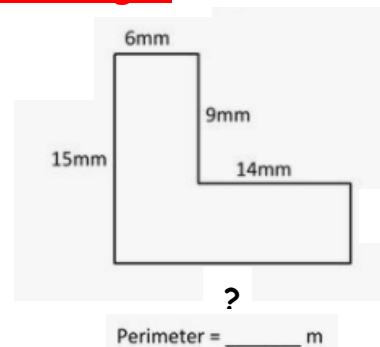

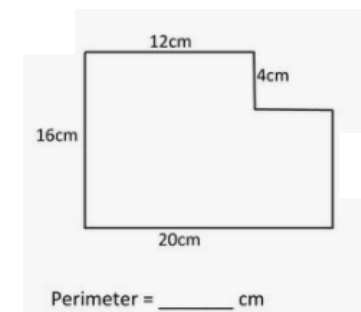
