Features of a Non - Chronological Report.	Text SWAMP MONSTERS Tick and give evidence below:
Does it have a title to tell you what the writing is about?	yes swamp monsters
Is there a general opening statement ?	yes do you ever wonder what lurks in the murky swamps of our world
Are there separate paragraphs about different parts of the report?	yes there is one about his habitat and one about how he looks
Is there technical vocabulary or words specific to the subject of the report?	yes indistinguishable environment habitat
Is there evidence used? (quotation from an expert)	yes Dr Patrick Thurston you cannot belive the pure majesty of the swamp monster. they seem as tho they are one with the swamp living in pure harmony with their habatat
Is it in the same tense all the way through? (past, present or future)	yes the text is all in past tense
Is it in a formal style?	yes the text is using very descriptive words to warn the public and do it in mature manner
Is there a concluding statement ?	yes if you are now tempted to go out and spot a swamp monster we advise extreme caution this beautiful but deadly creature should be left in solitude to be studied only by experts in monsterology
Are rhetorical questions used?	yes have you ever wondered what a swamp monster eats?
Is there a range of punctuation used? ? ! , ; : ()	yes I can spot ?!.,' '
