Yellow Cabs

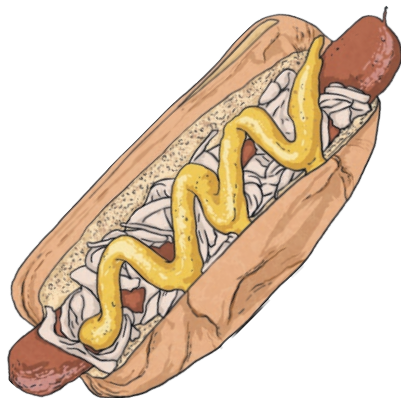
Did you know that New York has more than 13,000 yellow cabs?

Madison Square Garden



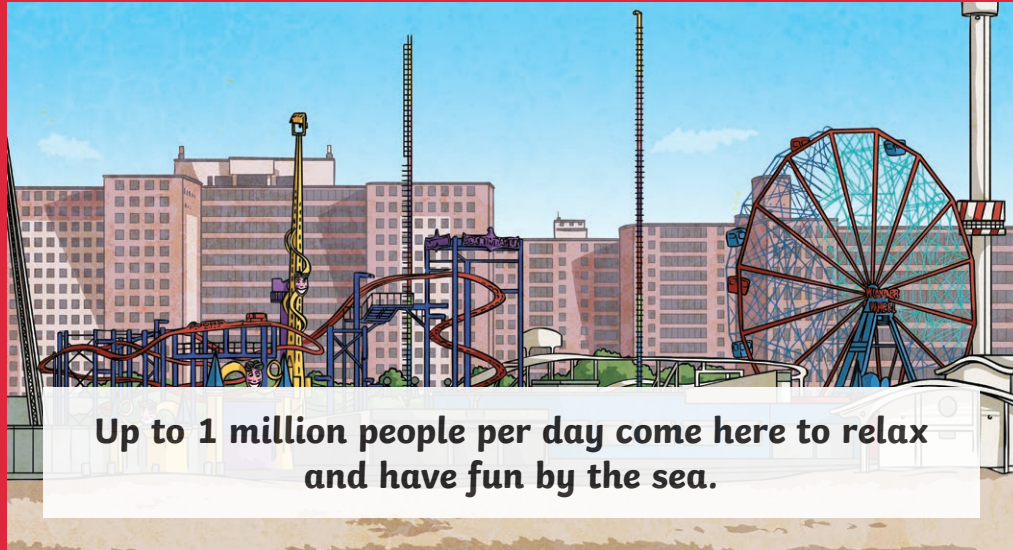
You can see ice hockey, music or basketball in the stadium.

Coney Island



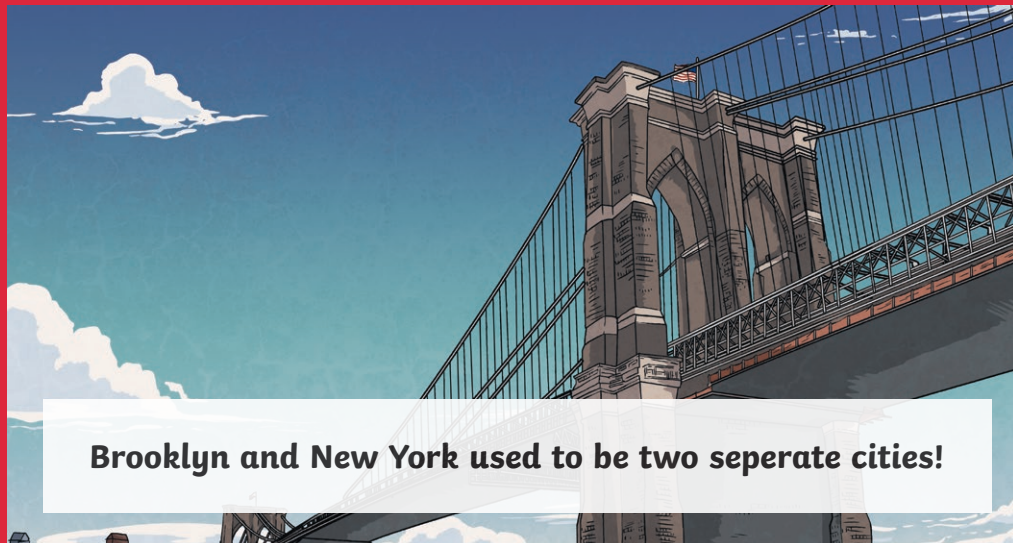
Up to 1 million people per day come here to relax and have fun by the sea.

Remember to: Greet the vendor.

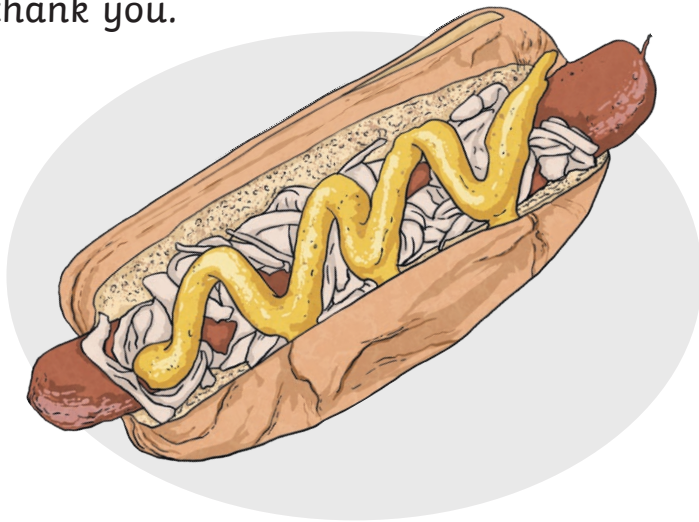
- Ask how much a ticket is.
