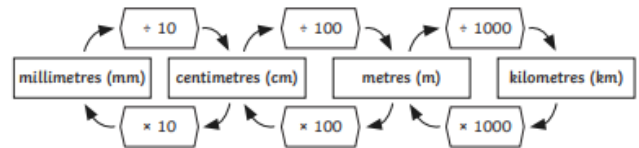

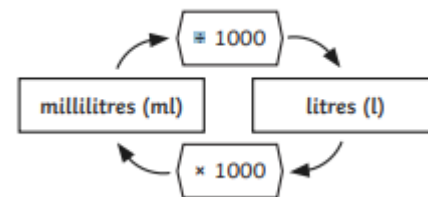

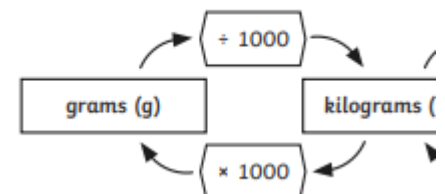


There are 1,000 kg in one tonne.
