

Y6 Residential visit to Kingswood: 20th – 22nd February 2023

Monday 20th February 2023

- Arrive at school at usual time, and head straight to the library to drop luggage then into class.
- Bring a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks, no glass bottles).

Wednesday 22nd February 2023

Return to school at about 14:30. A text message will be sent to parents confirming a more precise time, on the day.

Packing list

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Two pairs of trousers – tracksuit bottoms or similar (preferably quick drying – not jeans).		
Two t-shirts.		
Two sweatshirts or jumpers.		
Waterproof coat , hooded.		
Hat and gloves.		
An appropriate quantity of spare socks and underwear.		
Indoor shoes (pumps or slippers).		
Nightwear.		
Towel.		
Toothbrush and toothpaste.		
Soap/shower gel (in a sealed bag)/ deodorant (no aerosol).		
Hair brush/comb.		
Outdoor boots or shoes (preferably waterproof).		
A book/small game/notebook (for downtime).		

These must all be packed so that the child can carry everything independently.

n.b. No electronic devices such as mobile phones, tablets, MP3 players, etc. are to be brought.

Spending money

There is a small shop on site that children will be given the opportunity to visit. This is not the primary purpose of the residential visit, so we advise that children are not sent with large amounts of cash. Kingswood recommend that £10 maximum will be sufficient.

It is vital that all children behave in a safe and sensible manner when carrying out activities and when around the hostel, in order to get the most fun and enjoyment out of the experience.
