Learning Log Summer 2 : Pharaohs

In preparation for continuing with our theme **"Pharaohs"**, we have an exciting approach to homework that will give your child the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and 'creative flair'.

- Children choose their own method to present their learning.
- The tasks will be open ended.
- There is no one right way of presenting the work.

It would be GOOD if you could complete 4 out of the 9 activities.

It would be GREAT if you could use the internet in your work.

It would be AMAZING if you could complete a range of activities (write, research, make, discuss, draw)

Discuss: What did the Ancient Egyptians believe about the afterlife? How is this similar or different to your own beliefs?	Make: Find out how the Egyptians built their famous pyramids. Have a go at making your own.	Draw: Use the internet to find images of Ancient Egyptian artefacts. Practise your sketching skills by drawing these.
Design: Research Egyptian jewellery and have a go at designing your own.	Write: Have a go at writing using Egyptian hieroglyphics. Try writing your own secret message to decode.	Research: Can you find out why the scarab beetle was so important to the Ancient Egyptians?
Play: Travel back in time and get into character. You could dress up as a pharaoh, an explorer or even a mummy!	Research: Find out about the different Egyptian gods. You could present your findings as an information text or a leaflet.	Write: Find out about the process of mummification and create a gory set of instructions.
