Learning Log Spring 2 : South America Adventure

In preparation for continuing with our theme "South American Adventure", we have an exciting approach to homework that will give your child the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and 'creative flair'.

- Children choose their own method to present their learning.
- The tasks will be open ended.
- There is no one right way of presenting the work.

It would be GOOD if you could complete 4 out of the 9 activities.

It would be GREAT if you could use the internet in your work.

It would be AMAZING if you could complete a range of activities (write, research, make, discuss, draw)

Discuss: What rainforest plants can you think of that we eat or use to make other products?

Make: Can you practise your sewing skills we've learnt so far? You could make a tropical inspired bookmark.

Draw: Use the internet to find images of different textiles. Have a go at drawing the patterns.

Design: Create your own chocolate bar. How are you going to make people want to buy it?

Write: Imagine you are climbing up to the top of the rainforest. Use your senses to write a description.

Research: Find out how different textiles are made. How do materials get their colour?

Play: Get outside! Can you make a den like the one the children rebuilt in our story 'The Explorer'?

Research: Find out what palm oil is and what it is used for and where it comes from.

Write: A weather report for the city of Manaus, Brazil. Have a go at performing your report to an adult.
