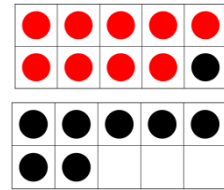

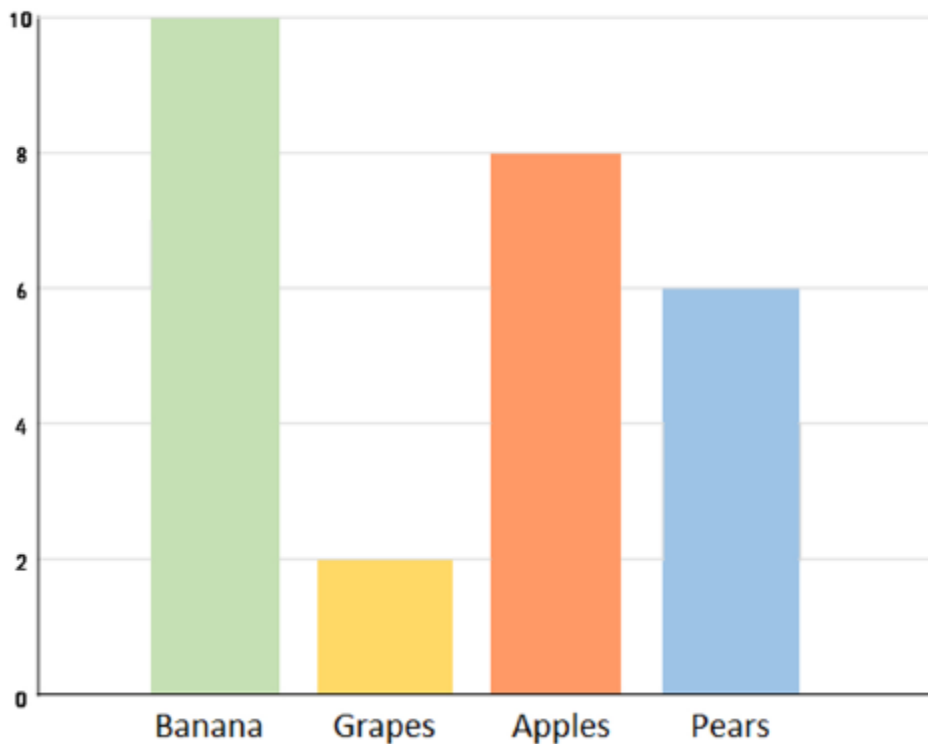
$$9 + 8 = 17$$
