Addition Learn Its

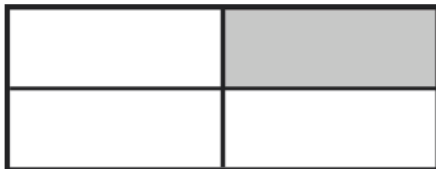

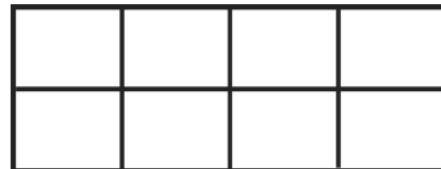

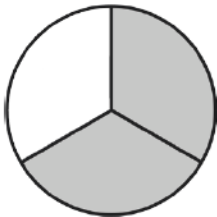
