Learning Log Spring 2 : South America Adventure

To continue our work on our current theme, "South America Adventure" we have an exciting approach to homework that will give your child the opportunity to demonstrate their knowledge and 'creative flair'.

- Children choose their own method to present their learning.
- The tasks will be open ended.
- There is no one right way of presenting the work.

It would be GOOD if you could complete 4 out of the 9 activities.

It would be GREAT if you could use the internet in your work.

It would be AMAZING if you could complete a range of activities (write, research, make, discuss, draw)

Discuss: What impact do humans have on the rainforests of the world?	Make: Have a go at listening to the sounds of the rainforest and making these using objects at home.	Draw: Use the internet to find pictures of topical plants and flowers and draw your own rainforest plants.
Design: A jungle inspired piece of clothing.	Write: An adventure story set in the depths of a tropical rainforest.	Research: Have a look at the work of Henri Rousseau. What do you like about his paintings?
Play: Can you create a shoebox rainforest? What do the animals get up to in your rainforest?	Research: Can you find out about the different layers of the rainforest? How have plants adapted?	Write: A descriptive poem about the animals in the rainforest.
