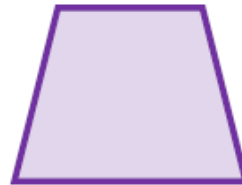
LO. To be able to measure the perimeter of 2D shapes.

Explain your answer.

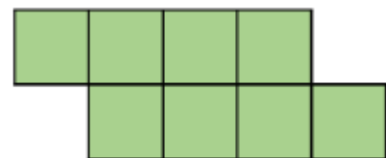
4. Amir is measuring the shape below.
