

A) Can you write the fact families for the following?

- 1) $2 \times 4 = 8$
- 2) $5 \times 4 = 20$
- 3) $6 \times 4 = 24$
- 4) $3 \times 4 = 12$
- 5) $9 \times 4 = 36$
- 6) $4 \times 4 = 16$
- 7) $10 \times 4 = 40$
- 8) $12 \times 4 = 48$
- 9) $7 \times 4 = 28$
- 10) $11 \times 4 = 44$
- 11) $8 \times 4 = 32$

e.g.

$$A1, 2 \times 4 = 8$$

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

$$8 \div 2 = 4$$

$$8 \div 4 = 2$$

B) Can you write the fact families for the following?

- 1) $2 \times 40 = 80$
- 2) $5 \times 40 = 200$
- 3) $6 \times 40 = 240$
- 4) $3 \times 40 = 120$
- 5) $9 \times 40 = 360$
- 6) $4 \times 40 = 160$
- 7) $10 \times 40 = 400$
- 8) $12 \times 40 = 480$
- 9) $4 \times 40 = 160$
- 10) $11 \times 40 = 440$
- 11) $8 \times 40 = 320$

e.g.

$$B1, 2 \times 40 = 80$$

$$40 \times 2 = 80$$

$$80 \div 2 = 40$$

$$80 \div 40 = 2$$
