This is a crotchet - we clap and say Ta

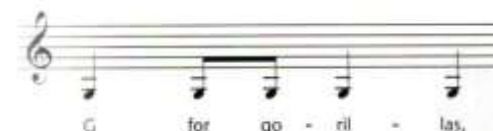
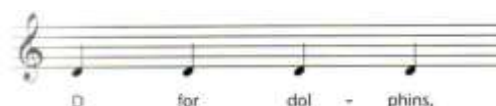


These are quavers (less tasty to eat) - we tap our knees and say Te-Te

One of the pieces we learnt was At The Zoo. Here are all the rhythms that we used:



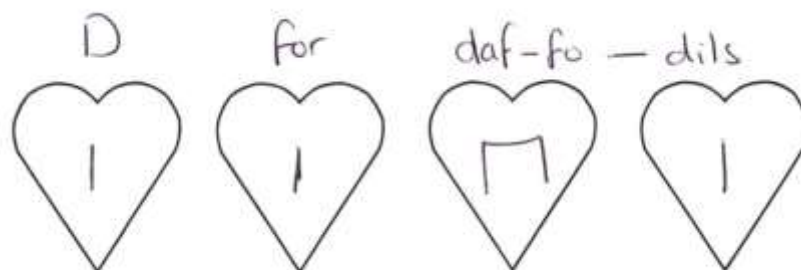
You are now going to create your own!
