 $50 + 50 = 100$ L + L = C
5. Make the first four multiples of 5
5, 10, 15, 20 V, X, XV, XX,
6. Make the answer to $80 \div 10 =$
 $80 \div 10 = 8$ LXXX $\div$ X = VIII
7. Create the number sentence $100 - \underline{\quad} = 10$
 $100 - 90 = 10$ C - XC = X

 $8 \div 4 = 2$ II

 $100 - 88 = 12$ C - LXXXVIII = XII

 $9 \times 8 = 72$ $72 - 10 = 62$ LXII
10. How many octopuses are there if there is a total of 40 legs?
 $40 \div 8 = 5$ LX $\div$ VIII = V

 8 , 16 , 24 , 32 $VIII$, XVI , $XXIV$, $XXXII$

 $6 \times 8 = 48$ $XLVIII$
4. Create the number sentence $68 + \underline{\quad} = 100$ using Roman numerals
 $68 + 32 = 100$ $LXVIII + XXXII = C$
5. Make the first four multiples of 9
 9 , 18 , 27 , 36 IX , $XVIII$, $XXVII$, $XXXVI$
6. Make the answer to $940 \div 10 =$
 $940 \div 10 = 94$ $XCIV$
7. Create the number sentence $100 - \underline{\quad} = 12$
 $100 - 88 = 12$ $C - LXXXVIII = XII$

 $7 \times 4 = 28$ $VII \times IV = XXVIII$

 $8 \times 8 = 64$ $64 - 20 = 44$ $XLIV$
10. How many octopuses are there if there is a total of 240 legs?
 $240 \div 8 = 30$ XXX
