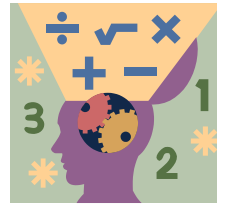

2. Hannah bought a pencil case for 289p. She paid with 143p. How much change did she get?

Can you work out what that is in pounds (£)?

3. A jug of water has 788ml of water in it. Adam pours 526ml out. How much water is left?

4. Peter is running a 500m race. He is 217m away from the finish line. How far has he already run?

5. A school is raising money for charity. Their target is £555. So far they have raised £321. How much money do they now need to raise to meet their target?

6. Jake is collecting stamps. At the moment, he has 559. He gives 100 to Rosie. He then gives 125 to Charlie. How many stamps does he have now?
