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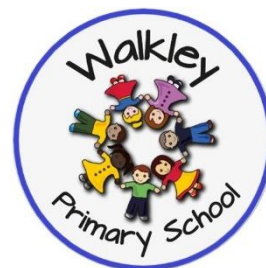

This year, 'Sports Day' will involve a carousel of activities, as well as the traditional races. It will take place **on both yards in the main school playground**. If the day it is too hot or wet, we will inform you of any schedule changes on the day via text.

On the Top Yard, Year 1 will compete in running races, while Year 2 will take part in carousel activities. After these events have finished, the year groups will swap over. Parents/carers can watch and cheer on their child from the grass bank. **Please make sure that your child has a water bottle, wears sun cream, (if necessary) a sun hat and a full PE kit to school on this day with the usual blue or black shorts, pumps/trainers and white t-shirt.**

We would like to invite parents/carers (weather permitting!) to join us for a picnic lunch after the mornings events to create a community feel to the morning as we felt this was a real success last year. After the events have taken place, the children will go back inside to get ready for lunch. At 12pm parents/carers can collect their child from their classroom door and have their picnic together on the school playground . At 12:30, a whistle will be blown and the children will line up with their class teacher and go back inside.

Children can either bring their own packed lunch or order a grab bag sandwich meal as usual on the morning register. No cooked meal choices will be available on this day. Children can sit with their parents/carers to eat lunch (adults may want to bring their own packed lunch!) Children who do not have an adult will still have their packed lunch sat with their teacher on the grass bank. Please bring a blanket if you have one. When the whistle is blown, please take your child to join the class line. **For safety reasons children need to stay with their adult at all times on the playground to eat their lunch. The trim trail and wooded area will not be available.**
