This week's *Learn Its* to practise are:

6 TIMES TABLE

$$6 \times 0 = 0$$

$$6 \times 1 = 6$$

$$6 \times 2 = 12$$

$$6 \times 3 = 18$$

$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

$$6 \times 5 = 30$$

$$6 \times 6 = 36$$

$$6 \times 7 = 42$$

$$6 \times 8 = 48$$

$$6 \times 9 = 54$$

$$6 \times 10 = 60$$

$$6 \times 11 = 66$$

$$6 \times 12 = 72$$

Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.)

How many times can you say each fact in 1 minute?

Subtraction on a numberline

I can remember to:

1. place your two numbers in order on the numberline.
2. make a mark roughly midway between them.
3. assign a sensible number to the mark (the next ten, the next hundred).
4. work out the jump from the smaller number to the mark.
5. work out the jump from the mark to the larger number.
6. add the two jumps together to find the total.
