6 TIMES TABLE

$$6 \times 0 = 0$$

$$6 \times 1 = 6$$

$$6 \times 5 = 30$$

$$6 \times 6 = 36$$

$$6 \times 7 = 42$$

$$6 \times 8 = 48$$

$$6 \times 9 = 54$$

$$6 \times 10 = 60$$

$$6 \times 11 = 66$$

$$6 \times 12 = 72$$

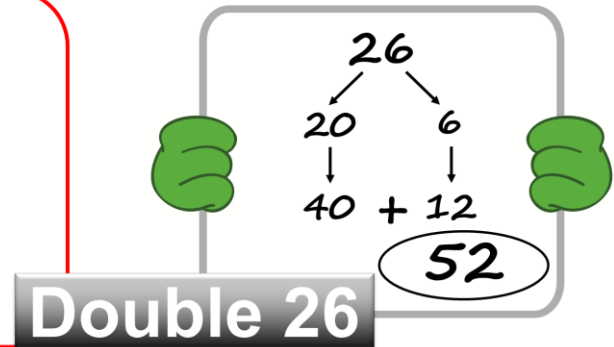
Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.)

Doubling and Halving

Remember to

- partition the 2d number
- double the tens
- double the units
- put them back together again



The above method also works for halving.
