

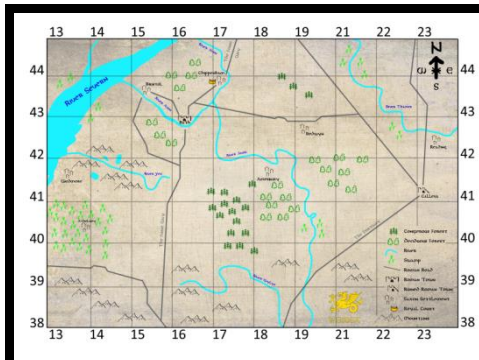

Make: A detailed model of dragon-headed Viking longship prow.	Research: Why is 1066 AD considered to be an important year?	Discover: What happens when you mix oil and water?
Make: An Anglo-Saxon shield.	Find Out: What causes climate change?	Move: Try to bounce a balloon in the air for more than five minutes.
Explain: How to create static electricity with a balloon.	Read: Perseus and the Gorgon.	Find Out: How were rivers used as borders? e.g. Meersbrook
