Read: A non-fiction book about Saxon-Age Britain.	Design: An Anglo-Saxon dress, tunic or helmet.	Write: A message in Runes.	
Create: A newsletter or documentary on how to save endangered animals.	Find Out: What did people eat during the Saxon Age?	Move: Try a 7-minute workout with the lazy monster. Type 'Lazy monster 7 min workout' in YouTube and it's the first video!	
Design: A poster on how to look after your teeth.	Read: about Beowulf. There should be many children's versions available at your local library.	Make: A model of an Anglo-Saxon village.
