Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.)

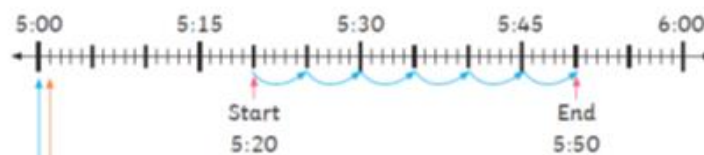
How many times can you say each fact in 1 minute?

Working out durations...

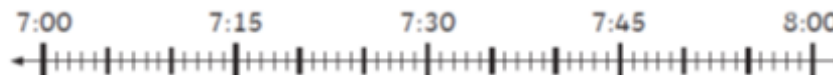
Use the number lines to help you calculate the answer for each question.
For example:

Danny starts watching cartoons at 5:20 p.m. They last for 30 minutes. What time does he stop watching cartoons?

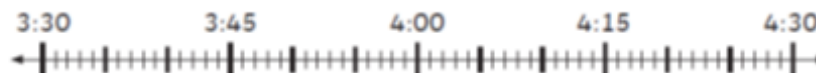


Each small line represents 1 minute and the larger thicker lines represent 5 minutes. Use this to help you count on.

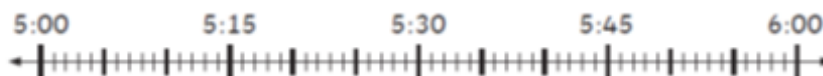
1. Anna wakes up at 7:20 a.m. She needs to set off for school in 25 minutes. What time does she need to set off for school?



2. Football club starts at 3:45 p.m. and ends at 4:20 p.m. How long does football club last?



3. Mark plays his video game for 45 minutes when he gets home. If he gets home at 5:05 p.m., what time does he finish playing his game?
