$$8 \times 4 = 32$$

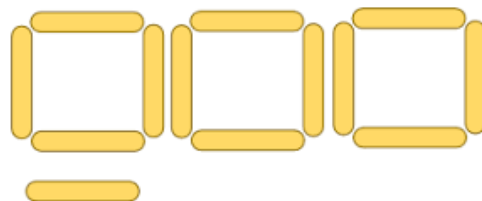
Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.)
