$$1 \times 3 = 3$$

$$2 \times 3 = 6$$

$$3 \times 3 = 9$$

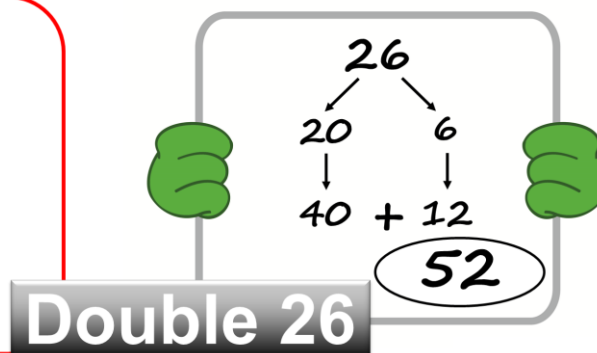
$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.) How many times can you say each fact in 1 minute?

Doubling and Halving

Remember to

- partition the 2d number
- double the tens
- double the units
- put them back together again



The above method also works for halving.

Use this method to practise doubling and halving two digit numbers.
