Discuss: What festivals do you know about from different countries? Are there any similarities between them?	Make: A traditional Mexican meal such as spicy fajitas. You could write your own recipe.	Write: A film review for Coco. Would you recommend it to others? What did you learn from the film?
Design: A traditional Dia de los Muertos mask and costume.	Write: An adventure story into another world.	Research: What can you find out about the ancient Mayan civilisation?
Play: Can you build a Mayan temple out of junk material?	Research: How do families celebrate 'Dia de los Muertos'? What traditional foods are eaten?	Draw: Practise drawing ancient Mayan hieroglyphics and symbols.
