- There is no one right way of presenting the work.

It would be GOOD if you could complete 4 out of the 9 activities.

It would be GREAT if you could use ICT in your work.

It would be AMAZING if you could complete a range of activities (write, research, make, discuss, draw)

Discuss: What traditional tales (fairy tales) do you know? Have you come across any from other countries?	Make: Create a bookmark using ancient Mayan hieroglyphics.	Draw: Create a picture of your favourite book and explain why you have chosen it.
Design: Can you design a piece of ancient Mayan jewellery?	Write a fact file about Mexican artist Frida Kahlo. You could include sketches of her artwork.	Research: What did the Maya, Aztecs and Incas eat? Why do these foods grown in this part of the world?
Play: Find out about the ancient Mayan ball game called pitz and have a go yourself.	Research: What can you find out about the ancient Mayan city Chichén Itzá?	Write : Draft and perform a weather report for a day in the Mexican desert.
