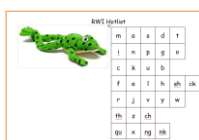


Read Write Inc

Science and our topic will be:

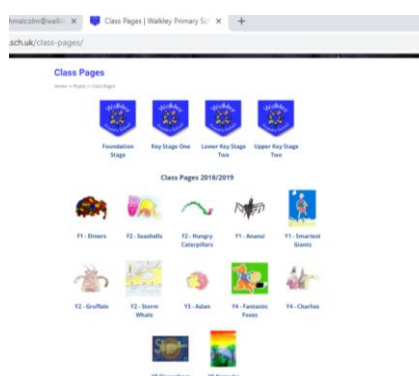
'What senses will we use to navigate to the moon?'
