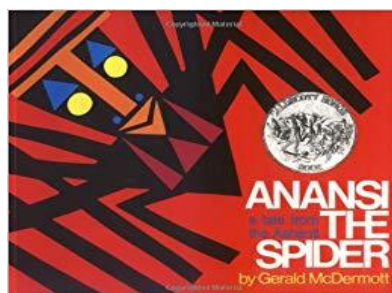

This term will be learning and applying counting skills to 100, forwards and backwards. We will concentrate on knowing our jigsaw numbers to 10 (number bonds) and we will be beginning to understand multiplication by making groups.

Furthermore, we will be recognising and using language related to dates, including days of the week. Children will receive maths homework that reinforces their class work. See the blog to download homework if your child has been absent. Maths homework is given out on Monday and handed in on Friday.
