$$1 + 9 = 10 \quad 2 + 8 = 10$$

$$3 + 7 = 10 \quad 4 + 6 = 10$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$

Try counting in 5s:

5, 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, 40, 45, 50,
55, 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95,
100

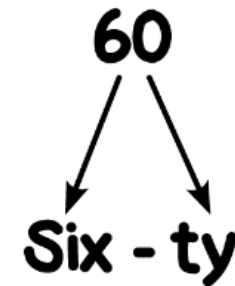
Try saying them in different voices (scared, happy, shout, whisper etc.)

For some tens numbers all you have to do is read the first number and add 'ty' on the end.
