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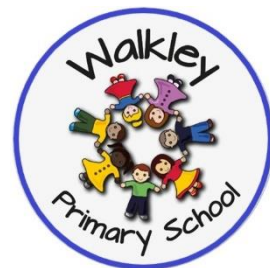

WPS – PE Code of Dress and indoor trainers/plimsolls

Clothing for PE Days

In the interests of safety and hygiene all children must attend school in suitable clothing for PE on their designated PE days. **Children should wear a white t-shirt or polo shirt and dark blue or black shorts or black leggings or jogging trousers. They should have separate indoor sports shoes or pumps for use in the hall. These can be left in school.**

A letter of explanation is required if your child cannot access PE lessons. Children should not wear jewellery in school, except for earring studs.

Newly pierced ears must be covered by tape supplied from home. This cannot be administered by Walkley staff. If your child cannot do this themselves they must come to school with tape already applied. For this reason, we do strongly suggest children's ears are pierced at the beginning of the summer holidays.

Long hair should be tied back. As our cloakrooms are too small to contain large sports bags, the children will need a small bag or pump bag in which to keep their indoor PE shoes.
