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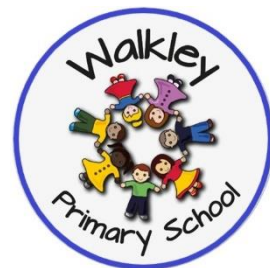

Key Stage 1 'Secret Agent Training'

Dear parents and carers,

During May, Year 2 children will be taking their Key Stage One National Curriculum assessments (SATs). The papers the children sit consist of English Reading, Mathematics and English grammar, punctuation and spelling. The assessments are a useful tool for teachers to help them measure your child's performance and identify their needs as they prepare to move in to Key Stage Two.

At Walkley, we take a relaxed approach to these assessments with the children and aim to ensure they have no worries and concerns. In fact, in the past, children have not even realised they have taken them! To your child, we describe these assessments as Secret Agent Training (SATs) and children are taken in small groups by Mr Wallis and Mrs Leverton throughout the month of May to take different papers and have a snack at the end. The tests are not timed and we try to create a relaxed environment. The results of these assessments will be posted to you in July 2022.

Best of all, the children will have a Secret Agent party at the end of May!

During this month, we would appreciate it if you could continue to read on a daily basis with your child for 10 -15 minutes and complete the online weekly homework of Spelling Shed, TT Rock Stars and maths quizzes.
