

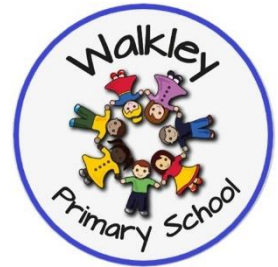

Covid – 19 Warn and Inform Letter to Y3 Aslans Class Parents

Dear Parents,

We have been advised that a high number of pupils have tested positive for COVID-19 within the Aslans class.

This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide advice on how to support your child. Please be reassured that for most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness.

The school remains open and your child should continue to attend as normal if they remain well. All families of those who we have identified as being a close contact within school are being informed.

For peace of mind you may wish to test your child using a lateral flow device (LFD) test.

You can access LFD tests from: <https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests>

You can pick up tests from a pharmacy and get up to 2 packs of 7 rapid tests. If you give the pharmacy a 'collect code' when you pick up the tests, it helps the NHS match your details to the tests. What to do if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) or tests positive for COVID-19

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19), they should get a PCR test and begin isolating. Anyone who tests positive will be able to leave self-isolation six days after the date of their initial positive test if they receive two negative lateral flow test results, 24 hours apart, on days five and six. Symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are a new, continuous cough, or a high temperature, or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).

If your child has a positive test result on a lateral flow device test, but does not have symptoms, they should stay at home and self-isolate for at least 6 days. On day 5 of the isolation take a Lateral Flow Device test and if this returns a negative result along with a further negative LFD test on day 6, your child can leave isolation and return to school. This isolation period will be extended if they go on to develop symptoms. Anyone with symptoms will be eligible for a PCR test (the normally available test type) and this can be arranged via: Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus (COVID-19) <https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test>
