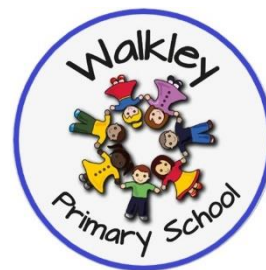

Children are encouraged to bring in a favourite bedtime book to share with their class. A voluntary donation of 50p is also encouraged in order to raise money for the Children's Hospital.

World Book Day celebrates the joy and value of books and reading, especially for students. To encourage and help them on their reading journey, every student will receive a £1 book token which can be exchanged for one free World Book Day 2022 book or £1 off a book costing £2.99 or more.
