

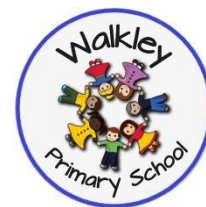

Coronavirus update – Spring Term 1 Provision for Free School Meals
Free school meals vouchers – Emailed directly to parents or posted to your home

Dear Parents / Carers

During these challenging times, we want to ensure that pupils eligible for free school meals can continue to access support. Walkley is using the National eVoucher scheme and we have made applications for you to receive a voucher for each eligible child in your household. Over the next few days, you will be receiving an eCode to your Email inbox from Edenred, the company delivering the National eVoucher scheme. **Parents who previously received their vouchers through the post will continue to do so. They will be sent to you when they arrive in school.**

- You will receive a single e-Code equivalent to £15 per week for every eligible child for the 4 weeks up to half term break:
 - Week beginning 18th January 2021 to week beginning 8th February 2021 inclusive.
 - This amounts to £60 per child (2 children eligible in household will receive £120 voucher, 3 children eligible will receive £180 voucher)
- Once you have received your eCode by Email you can convert it into an eGift Card voucher to spend on food and drink for your child at one of the following supermarkets. **Be sure to check your Spam Folder and other folders within your Email application for your eCode.**
