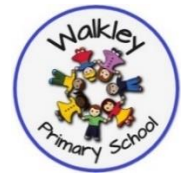


Walkley Primary School – Information for parents and pupils

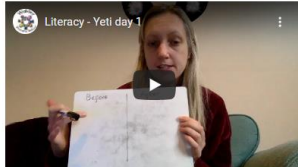

-Make your before and after notes about the yeti (you may want to pause the video at the appropriate time to do this.)

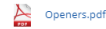
-Write a character description of the yeti, with two paragraphs for before and after.

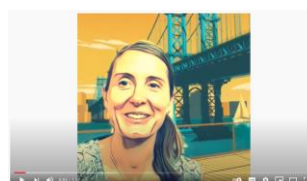
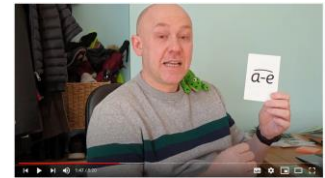
There will be 2 types of forms:

- If a teacher is asking your child to upload a photo of some work then you will need to have a google account to send the work to us. Please try to send your work back to teachers this way and not via email enquiries@ as it this significantly increases the workload of our lovely office staff.
- If a teacher is asking you to answer questions, then you won't need a google account, and you should get instant feedback if the questions are correct.

Videos:

For each subject you will find daily learning posted by the teacher, ready for your child to access from home. This is the same content that the pupils in school will be accessing. We have a team of staff working to provide the learning that all pupils can access. Very often this will be a video for your child to watch that teaches the new learning needed to complete the tasks in that subject for the day or sequence of days. Videos are great; you can play them when ready, pause for a break and replay if needed. We have found this a far more successful and mindful strategy than live streaming lessons.

The Walkley staff have become YouTubers and have already excitedly begun creatively making learning videos ready for next week.
