The teaching team has been structured to support all pupils, catering for our key worker pupils, the pupils returning to school in F2, Y1 and Y6 and our pupils accessing work from home. Many staff have returned to working their full hours in school, so we have separated the home learning into these specific age groups to enable our smaller home-learning team to continue to post quality learning for all our pupils.

What to Expect

Foundation Stage

The Elmers blog will continue as a weekly update of topic based activities. In Foundation 2 there will now be one central blog page with daily topic based activities (our current topic is Amazing Adventures). There will also continue to be a weekly science activity, story time and a Friday disco song.

Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2

We will continue to post daily maths lessons for Key Stage 1, for Lower Key Stage 2 and for Upper Key Stage 2. There will be a range of tasks to select from to ensure all pupils can access the learning. Please be aware that some of the content may be a consolidation of topics already covered. In Literacy, there will be weekly reading, spelling and grammar tasks in addition to a longer writing task. In the Creative section, we will be posting a range of activities covering different curriculum areas.

Our home learning team may be required to cover in school so we will keep you informed of any further changes.
