Dear Parent / Carer

Thank you so much for the work you are doing in our community as a key worker. Walkley will stay open to look after the children of key workers so that families can keep delivering essential services. The Local Authority, Walkley Primary School and other schools in the local area are looking into ways where key worker pupils from different schools attend just one setting, this means pupils might attend a different setting to their usual school alongside key worker pupils from other schools. This will help mitigate staffing issues, unnecessary costs and safeguarding. We would of course inform you if this is something we need to do in the future.

We intend to continue to do everything we can to support you; hopefully this will mean that health workers can continue to provide the care they need to, that Social Workers can keep checking on the vulnerable and that drivers can keep food and essential supplies being delivered. Whatever it takes, we will be here to support for as long as we are able.

In line with Government and Learn Sheffield expectations, **if children can stay safely at home, they should, to limit the chance of the virus spreading.** If you would like us to maintain a place for your child over the coming weeks, we ask that families who include a key worker, and are unable to keep their child at home, complete the timetable attached. Please indicate the sessions you would like school to provide and return it to us via email, so that we can establish the staffing required to support the children remaining in school. One way of doing this would be to take a photo of the timetable and email it to enquiries@walkley.sheffield.sch.uk **If you do not contact us, we will assume you do not require a place.**

School opens at 8am for Breakfast at the normal Breakfast Club door, or alternatively at 8.50am at the Main Reception. At these times, when you are more likely to come into contact with others, do please maintain the 2m distance advice to minimise risk of transmission.

Thank you all for your continued support and understanding and especially to those parents and carers who have taken the time to send in encouraging messages over the past couple of weeks.
