We hope your child has enjoyed learning to play the violin in school this year!

Would your child like to continue learning the violin? This is possible in school!

Did you know that learning a musical instrument can help children to be happier, more successful, confident and self-assured? Our school will be offering 'Pathways' lessons with Heather Burge from Sheffield Music Hub, for those children who wish to continue learning the instrument this year.

Children will learn in groups of up-to 10 children per half-hour. This is because we believe that learning in a group is the best way to start out learning a new instrument. The cost of lessons will be £10 per half term, PAYABLE IN ADVANCE, that's less than £2 per lesson! If you will find it difficult to pay, please contact the office. Sheffield Music Hub will deliver 33 lessons in a year (normally 11 per term), there are 39 school weeks so there will not always be a lesson every week. Lessons are due to commence on Thursday 19th September.

If you take up this offer your child will be provided with an instrument to take home for practice. You will need to take responsibility for the safety of the instrument.
