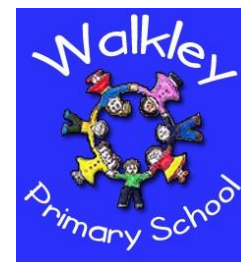

In order to complete all the activities on the schedule, good timing is essential so if you would like to attend the event please arrive by **9.15am for the morning session and 1.15 for the afternoon session**. There will be signs to guide you where to go.

Children will be supervised by their teachers in their class areas. You will be able to watch the activities from the parent viewing area. Please bring a fold up chair if you have one or a blanket if you wish to sit on the bank. For safety reasons you will not be able to sit with your child. Following the races, children will be escorted back to the classrooms by staff ready for a prompt lunch.

Stickers will be awarded for races on the day and small prizes will be presented in Golden Assembly on Friday 13th July for the carousel activities.

Please make sure that your child has a full PE kit in school, consisting of a **white T-shirt, blue or black shorts and pumps/trainers**. They will be provided with drinks. If it is a sunny day it would also be advisable to send your child with a sun hat/baseball hat as there is not a lot of shade. Please note that sun cream cannot be administered by staff.

Last year we had to shorten the event considerably due to high temperatures. We hope this year that the weather will be more favourable. However, if it is too hot or wet we will inform you of any schedule changes on the day via text.
