Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited about our upcoming trip to Cleethorpes on 26th June 2019. If you have not yet paid for the trip please take your permission slip and payment to the school office ASAP.

Here is some important information. **Please read carefully.**

Times

To make the most of our day, we need to leave early. **The gates will be open for F2 Pupils only at 8.00am.**

Children who normally attend breakfast club will need to come straight to class.

We are aiming to be back at school by 4pm. If there is any change to the time of our arrival you will be contacted via text message.

Lunch and snacks

Children will be provided with a **packed lunch** from school which will include a sandwich, snack and fruit.

They will all need a **backpack** which is comfortable and easy to carry on their back. All pupils will need a **water bottle**. Extra water will also be carried by staff. We will be having chips on the beach provided by a local café. If your child has an allergy, please speak to us prior to the trip.

Safety

The beach has been visited by staff prior to the trip and a detailed risk assessment has been carried out.

Precautions have been taken to ensure pupil safety at all times.

Sun safety and clothing

Children can wear their own clothes but **no football shirts please**. We are hoping for good weather so be sure to apply an **all-day sunscreen** to your child in the morning before the trip. If your child is particularly sensitive to the sun, we recommend that they wear long sleeves.

All children must have a suitable sun hat. If they do not have a hat, please let us know and we will endeavor to help. We will also be taking a portable shelter. Pupils may also need a thin raincoat incase the weather turns during the trip. If your child is prone to toilet accidents please also include spare underwear and trousers. Due to safety regulations there will be no swimming. **Please do not send swimsuits.**

Money

Pupils will not need to bring money.

Travel sickness

The journey will take an hour and a half. If your child is prone to travel sickness please let us know and we will make sufficient provision for them.
