Y6 Crucial Crew Visit

On Monday 14th January 2019, the Y6 children will be attending 'Crucial Crew', at the Lifewise Centre in Rotherham. This is an annual event and part of 'The South Yorkshire Police Children and Young People Intervention Programme,' aiming to keep young people safe and promote positive citizenship. It is also an important part of the Y6 preparations for secondary school, highlighting the responsibilities and accountabilities of growing independence.

In order to arrive at the Lifewise Centre in good time for the start of the day, we need to leave Walkley at 8.50am by coach, and therefore, request that children are at school for 8.35am on that morning. We are due to return to school by 3:20pm although, depending on traffic, there is a small chance that we will be a few minutes later than this

Children should wear normal school uniform and sensible footwear. They will also need a packed lunch and drink (no fizzy drinks) in a bag which they will need to carry. If they normally receive school dinners, one will be provided for them. There is a **£8 contribution** for this trip which covers coach fare to and from the venue.
